Notes from Katrina (sent out pre-meeting as she wasn't able to attend the meeting in person):

- Prices increase for hot lunches as not affected our overall ordering numbers, which is good. Note we are not making near as much profit from BP's as previous terms. (Previously they charged \$2.99+GST = \$3.15 per meal. We were charging \$5 per meal to parents = \$1.85 profit per meal). Now we are lucky to get \$1. I am hoping that with increasing pizza as well that our overall margins will be the same, but we will have to wait till term 2 is over to view the final numbers.
- 2. TD Bank has been horrible to deal with. Over the last 6 months, I have gone into the bank over half a dozen times to try and change signatories. Each time I am told yes, and I will hear from them in a week or so. And I never do. I have called, emailed, etc. No luck. Marnee has also tried. I called and left a message with the bank manager today... hopefully I hear something back.
- 3. I transferred money into the Gaming Account last month after the meeting (so that the balance would be over \$1,000) but we still got hit with monthly fees this month. I will follow up with the bank to confirm what the balance needs to be to avoid monthly charges.

Discussed fundraising/event ideas from parent responses on Facebook:
