## DPAC Report: Sarah Lauman

Sarah is Distract PAC president. Discussion held over the roles PAC, DPAC, and BCCPAC play.
PAC: All parents in a given school are members of a PAC, whether they're at the meeting or not. Executive runs the PAC. Focus is on school-level initiatives. Fundraising is not the main role. The main role is to work with admin in school, make sure things are communicated to parents and hep parents advocate for their children.

DPAC: Reps from each PAC in the district attend district meetings. There's an executive with members from each of the schools, bringing together the whole district. Focus is education, advocacy, and communications at district level.

BCCPAC: All PACs in the district attend in a provincial capacity and work with the ministry. They work with DPAC and everything trickles down.

## Chain of communication

There will be a handout to explain, but the communication begins with the person closest to the issue (teacher). If you don't get a resolution, speak to Vice President or President. If there's still no resolution, then go to the district and work your way up.

DPAC organizes speakers and presenters on a district level. Other PACs can bring in speakers, etc. too. Trustee forum (after election) will be communicated. What is a trustee? Why is your vote important?

Trustee forum takes place 7pm, Monday October 3 at VSS. Parents can attend and ask questions.

## Ongoing Business: Trish Hanke

Butcher Boys receipts - VERY IMPORTANT TO THE SCHOOL. This money pays for treats, staff appreciation, food at Apple Blossom fair, snacks for students that need it, etc.

Receipts are collected all year and PAC is given 1 percent credit back. In March and April of that year, receipts are put into the bucket, and with those receipts we get $2.5 \%$ back in credit and 2.5\% back in cash. Discussion held.
